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## GAME CHANGERS BY THE BOTTLE

From young pioneers breaking all the rules to Old World veterans passionately adhering to endangered traditions, this section presents vigneronns whose work is in some way vital. They remind us of why we love wine.

### Basket Range: Australia's Birth of Cool

The tiny town of Basket Range (population of 374) in the Adelaide Hills has become the unlikely leader of Australia's New Wave, based on a naturalistic, European-influenced approach. Home to a gang of daring, unconventional winemakers, the Basket Range is staging a spirited revolt against the overblown wines of the 1990s and early 2000s, striving to define a new era of delicious, terroir-driven wines.

The whites, Chenin blanc, offer textural elegance and mineral-hewn fruit while the reds, based on Cabernet franc, are energetic & focused with crunchy red fruit and the thrilling scent of spring rain.

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## GROWER CHAMPAGNE BY THE BOTTLE

A revolution in Champagne: Grape growers are deciding to make their own wine. Historically, Champagne has been produced by large houses who buy grapes from across the region to produce a consistent, but homogeneous product. This blurs the fact that Champagne is as diverse and compelling as any wine region on earth. The wines listed below are not sweeping blends, but instead come from specific places. Thus their great beauty is that they enable us to look at Champagne from the perspective of terroir.

**Gaston Chiquet** Blanc de Blancs Brut d'Ây | 137

Among the greatest of all grower-producers, Chiquet was the first to stop selling his grapes. This chardonnay comes from a Grand-Cru rated village for Pinot noir – and it shows in its weight and richness. The truest expression of terroir in Champagne.

**Chartogne-Taillet** Cuvée St. Anne Brut – Merfy | 126

One of Champagne's rising stars. Perfection: chalky and gently perfumed. It's not about the fruit, but about the flow of heavenly juice across the palate.

**Pierre Peters** Cuvée de Réserve Brut Blanc de Blancs – Mensil-sur-Oger | 155

The very best of NV blanc de blancs. From the same Grand Cru vineyards as Krug and Salon, this wine offers crystalline precision — among the purest expressions of Chardonnay in Champagne.

**Nathalie Falmet** Cuvée Brut Nature – Côte des Bars | 135

Falmet farms just three hectares in the Côte des Bars, Champagne's southern outpost. This electrifying cuvée is composed entirely of Pinot noir, sourced from a half-hectare vineyard, providing fruity mousse coupled with a freshness reminiscent of nearby Chablis.

**Marie Courtin** Cuvée Résonance – Côte des Bars | 117

This cuvee is made from 100% Pinot noir, farmed biodynamically, and fermented and aged in stainless steel with zero dosage. It's generous, textured, and with great depth. It's also rare: only 9,000 bottles are produced.
